Special Notes -

- Academic year denotes to the period starting with the academic session i.e. 1st August and ending with the examination or start of vacations during both the semesters falling within that academic year.
- The Tuition and Residential fees are collected twice an academic year on semester basis.
- The Programme Tuition and Residential fees may be subject to an annual increase up to ten percent (10%).
- O.P. Jindal Global University serves **only vegetarian food** in its dining halls on campus. Non-vegetarian food is available on payment basis from the University Food Village.
- Students are provided with a shared accommodation in the Residence Hall/Student Housing where three or four students share one hostel room, some of which have composite bed units.
- JGU follows a car-free policy inside the campus for parents and students. Students cannot keep cars either inside the campus or the parking area outside the campus or park their cars on Sonipat Narela Road.
