Congratulations! I am pleased to announce the Scholarship Awards Committee has awarded you the *International Diversity Scholarship* beginning Fall 2020. You have been awarded this scholarship because you have demonstrated good academic standing, financial need, and a commitment to our university and your home community. By receiving this award, your out-of-country fees are waived, a savings of around \$10,000 per year (determined by the number of course credit hours enrolled in).

The *International Diversity Scholarship* is renewable for 4 consecutive academic years, including summers, as long as you maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA. In addition, you must maintain your F-1 visa status at all times. The scholarship will be terminated for students who become legal permanent residents of the United States or violate visa status. **The scholarship cannot be extended beyond four academic years, even if you have not yet completed your degree program.** Please consider this before deciding to add or change majors or to take a semester long internship as this may lengthen the time required to complete degree requirements.

Please return the enclosed letter of intent to indicate that you plan to attend Georgia Southern University, Statesboro Campus and accept the *International Diversity Scholarship*. Please note that the scholarship will not be applied to your account until we receive your letter of intent.

Congratulations on receiving this award. This is quite an accomplishment and you should be very proud. We hope that you accept the scholarship and look forward to seeing you excel in your endeavors at Georgia Southern.
