Congratulations on your admission to the Ohio University fall 2022 entering class! I am pleased to inform you that you have been selected to receive the following OHIO Excellence Awards program funding at Ohio University:

OHIO Excellence Scholarship

\$4,500 Annually

\$18,000 Total Renewable Value

In order to maintain this renewable* scholarship award, you must carry at least 12 credit hours per semester and earn a 3.00 (out of 4.0) overall grade point average annually.

OHIO Trustee Award

\$5,000 Annually

\$20,000 Total Renewable Value

In order to maintain this renewable* scholarship award for non-residents of the state of Ohio, you must carry at least 12 credit hours per semester, earn a 3.00 (out of 4.0) overall grade point average annually, and remain a student paying non-resident tuition and fees.

* Awards are renewable for three additional academic years of undergraduate study on the Athens campus, are not available during the summer term, and expire with the spring term 2026. To secure your award, submit your housing contract and housing deposit (or housing exemption form) by May 1, 2022 at www.ohio.edu/admitted, and enroll on the Athens campus beginning with the fall term 2022. Visit www.ohio.edu/ohio-excellence-awards for more information; some exclusions apply.

A portion of your OHIO Excellence Awards may be provided through the generous support of donors, alumni and friends of the University. You will be notified during the fall semester of your freshman year if a part of your award is funded through donor support. In that circumstance, the overall value of your scholarships through the OHIO Excellence Awards program would remain the same, and you may be asked to send a note of thanks.

The OHIO Excellence Awards program also includes a grant program with a financial need component. To be considered, you should complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.gov. FAFSA results received after January 15, 2022 will be considered as funding allows.
