

Welcome to the University of Northern British Columbia,

Congratulations! I am happy to inform you that you have been admitted to UNBC.

To accept your offer of admission to UNBC and receive your admission letters, we require you to make an admission deposit of \$7500 CDN to your UNBC student account. Once this deposit is made, your official UNBC Letter of Admission will be emailed to you and the hard copy will be sent to you by mail.

Please pay this deposit within 14 days of receipt of this email to secure your seat in the program. Seats will be awarded on the first come first served basis. After July 30, 2020 your application will be cancelled and you will be required to re-apply to be considered for a future semester at UNBC. While July 30, 2020 is the final deadline to pay your deposit, you cannot apply for a study permit until you have received your admission letters. Study permit processing times vary by country and choosing to delay your deposit could affect the likelihood of receiving a student permit before the semester begins.
