Start with letting us know if you plan to attend UVic. To confirm, you must <u>submit a \$200 acceptance deposit</u> **no** later than May 1. Note that paying your deposit is the only thing you need to do to accept your offer.

The acceptance deposit must be received by the Tuition Fee Office before you can access the registration system. This deposit is **non-refundable**, however it will be credited toward your tuition fees. It can be paid via internet banking through your banking institution – set up the payee as *University of Victoria Tuition Fees* and the account number is your student number (V0XXXXXXX, as shown above). Registration for September and January courses begins in mid-June. You will be sent a pre-registration email with further information in late May provided that you have paid your acceptance deposit by the deadline. It is important to remember that enrolment in most courses is limited and that admission to the university does not guarantee registration in any specific course.

IMPORTANT: If you need to arrange for a study permit, we will send you separate study permit information by email once you have paid your \$200 acceptance deposit. Although it is usually non-refundable, please note that we will provide you with a refund in the event that you are denied a study permit by <a href="Citizenship and Immigration Canada">Citizenship and Immigration Canada</a> (proof will be required).
