Congratulations on behalf of St. George's University School of Medicine, Grenada. I am pleased to inform you that you have been accepted into the St. George's University School of Medicine in association with Ramaiah. The Five-Year Pathway program will commence on Monday. September 21<sup>St</sup>, 2020. We believe you possess the right combination of intellect, motivation, ability, and compassion to turn your ambition into success. As a result of your dedication and hard work, you are now one step closer to achieving your dream of becoming a doctor.

As part of your acceptance into the program, you are required to participate in and successfully pass, by scoring a grade C or better, the MATH 131 - Math for Physical Sciences course which will be taken in parallel with your pre-clinical medicine courses. The Math course will be delivered online by faculty from St. George's University's School of Arts and Sciences (SAS). Please note as soon as you are registered as an SGU student, you are required to start the Math class. You will receive a communication shortly with more details regarding your placement in the course.

Year I of the program begins with the preclinical certificate year by Ramaiah University of Applied Sciences and acts as a pathway to SGU School of Medicine. You will be subject to the progression requirements stipulated in the student manual. Upon meeting all first-year requirements at Ramaiah University of Applied Science, you will progress to Year 2 of the Pathway during which you can choose to study at either St. George's University, Grenada, or our affiliated campus at Northumbria University in Newcastle, UK. Year 3 of the program will take place on SGU's Grenada campus and the final two years will be your clinical rotations in the US and/or UK. Please note that any student who is a US Citizen or US Permanent Resident is required to sit the MCAT exam prior to promotion into the four-year MD program.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the full Fall 2020 term will be conducted via online distance learning. As part of the Fall 2020 virtual curriculum, students may participate as they would on campus via live online lectures, live interaction with faculty, small-group sessions, and personalized academic support.

A mandatory online Orientation Program commences on Monday, September 21, 2020 preceding the start of classes on Monday, September 28, 2020. Please carefully read the Acknowledgment of Admission form and return it to your admission counselor electronically.

Your deposit amount of 2,000 USD\* will be due on August 29, 2020. Please remit the amount of deposit to Gokula Education Foundation in Indian National Rupees (INR)\* (please refer to the footnote below, as indicated by (\*), for further information on exchange rate). Your tuition is due by September 7th, which you can remit to the same account.

## St. George's University of Grenada School of Medicine (SGU) in association with Ramaiah

Five Year Medical Program
Understanding of US Federal Aid Ineligibility

Please note that, US Citizens and permanent residents of the United States who attend the first year of the 4-year SGU/Northumbria University MD program (start of the MD basic sciences year) at Northumbria University will not be eligible to receive USDOE loans **throughout** their medical education at SGU. Student federal loan eligibility, for all foreign medical schools, is dependent on taking the Basic Science portion of the program, the first and second year of the 4-year MD program, on the main campus in Grenada.

I acknowledge and understand that by matriculating in the SGU School of Medicine/Northumbria pathway and as a US Citizen/permanent resident, I am not eligible to receive USDOE loans throughout my medical education at SGU. Should I be in need of financial assistance to meet my educational expenses, private loans would be the only available option and that I would need to meet the lender's eligibility criteria in order to qualify for a private educational loan, and that there is no guarantee that I would qualify for a private loan. I also understand and acknowledge that SGU does not offer any private loans to students who matriculate into the SGU School of Medicine/NU.
