Criminal History Screening

All students at Flinders who are enrolling in courses with a clinical or placement component which may involve contact with children, young people and vulnerable adults are required to undergo a Criminal History Screening prior to undertaking any placement in order to meet placement agencies 'duty of care' to clients. Students with 'relevant' criminal records may not be permitted to undertake their placements and may therefore not be able to complete their course requirements.

Upon arrival in Australia, international students are required to provide an original Police Check from their country of origin to the Medical Course Administration. Once students have been in Australia more than 6 months, they are required to undertake a Criminal History Screening check with the Department for Communities and Social Inclusion (DCSI).
