After submission, if for some reason, you would like to withdraw your admission, your enrollment deposit will be refunded after deducting INR 5,000/-, provided such a request is received on admission@flame.edu.in before May 09, 2022.

This offer of admission is contingent upon meeting the educational eligibility criteria as outlined in Annexure I. You must satisfy the minimum qualification for admission stated in Annexure I on or before September 30, 2022. Failure to do so would automatically result in the cancellation of your admission.

Notes to the schedule of fees:

1. * Program fees includes charges for mandatory sports courses (first year).
2. ** Lodging & Boarding fees are applicable for the duration of the academic year. Additional stay beyond the academic year (if permitted) shall be charged extra on a pro-rata basis. There are three types of housing facilities:
 - a. Apartment style twin sharing rooms with common bathroom facilities shared by flat-mates – charges as per the fee schedule table above.
 - b. Apartment style twin sharing rooms with attached bathroom facilities allocated on a first come first serve basis - additional charges of INR 75,000 will be charged for the duration of the academic year.
 - c. Apartment style twin sharing air-conditioned rooms with attached bathroom facilities allocated on a first come first serve basis – additional charges of INR 90,000 will be charged for the duration of the academic year.

Note: Though every effort shall be made to provide housing of your first preference, FLAME University does not guarantee the same and the University shall allocate housing according to availability and suitability.

3. ** Lodging & Boarding component of the fee structure includes dining charges and laundry charges up to 40 clothes per month.
4. *** Other fees include charges for IT services, on-campus medical expenses, counselling, sports, gymnasium and University bus service from campus to Pune city (Fergusson College Road) and back.
5. **** Additionally, a one-time refundable caution money deposit of INR 70,000 will be charged at the time of admission.
6. ***** Some miscellaneous costs like field trips for experiential learning courses, domestic / local / international immersions, specialization specific software, stationery, consumables, printing, photocopying, books, study material, sports equipment & consumables and alumni charges etc. are not included in the above-mentioned fees. They will be charged at actuals.

Annexure IV

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

- Scholarships are awarded for the full duration of the program. The annual scholarship award is divided equally between two semesters.
- The Scholarship Committee will review the performance of the scholarship student every term/semester. The continuation of the scholarship is dependent on student's maintaining a GPA and CGPA of 7.50 or more in every term/ semester of the program in which the student has enrolled in. If a scholarship student fails to meet this criterion during a particular semester, he/she will be placed on "Academic probation" for the next semester, and he/she will lose the scholarship for that semester. If a student fails to meet the above criteria for more than two consecutive semesters, the student will forgo the scholarship completely.
- Scholarship withdrawal may be initiated by the university against the students for certain disciplinary reasons too.
- The selected scholarship student shall work on campus for no more than 12 hours per week for the terms/semesters in which the student receives the scholarship benefit.
- The scholarship amount will not be paid to the selected student. It will be deducted from the term/semester dues directly.
- In case a scholarship student withdraws from the program, the student has to refund the scholarship amount that the University has already disbursed.
- The Scholarship Committee reviews the scholarships from time to time and reserves the right to alter, modify, change or withdraw any of the provisions and policies.

Should any of the information given by the scholarship recipient be found inaccurate or false at any time during the program, the scholarship award will be withdrawn and the recipient will either be charged full payment of fees immediately or will be dismissed from the program.
